I made several revisions to improve the clarity, flow and effectiveness of my presentation.

- a. I added a slide in the beginning that gave some background on Michigan Technological University as a company. It informs the audience of who the proposal is for while stating Michigan Tech's goals as a university and business.
- b. I also changed the title for the third slide from "The current Situation" to "The Problem". I thought this made the issue clearer and helped the presentation flow more logically to the proposed solution.
